

## HTXelerator to bring accessible training for future-focused leaders

**HOUSTON, TX – July 19, 2021** - Launching from The Cannon Downtown and The Ion in September 2021, the mission of the HTXelerator is to identify and prepare future-focused leaders for public service, specifically boards, commissions, and eventually city council.

Similar to a tech accelerator, the three-month program trains class members on the nuts and bolts of city government and ends with a competition known as The Pitch, which enables each participant to put forward a policy platform for a hypothetical race.

Topics covered during the immersive opening and closing weekend retreats and the 90-minute weekly education sessions include transportation, public safety, land use, diversity and social equity, economic development, homelessness, city finances, utilities, media training, and how to run a campaign.

The program is affordable at \$195 per a participant to ensure accessibility, diversity, and equal representation across the city of Houston.

Cohort members will be announced by August 13<sup>th</sup>, 2021. There is no fee to apply, <a href="https://www.htxelerator.org/application">https://www.htxelerator.org/application</a>.

The HTXelerator is a 501(c)(3) charitable nonprofit corporation.
